

Doug Beach Memorial Scholarship

Doug Beach graduated from Syracuse High School as a member of the class of 1977. He was passionate about the cow/calf operation his family built together, and spent much of his time working at Beach Seeds/Fontanelle Hybrids. Doug was an invested member of the Syracuse community with his involvement including coaching youth teams, being a member of the Syracuse Fire Department, serving as a longtime leader of 4-H, and being a member of the Fontanelle Hybrids Dealer Council. His passion for agriculture and his community went far beyond these roles, as he was known for, "never being too important to be kind to people." This scholarship honors his memory.

Amount of Scholarship: A scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded to a graduating senior pursuing post-secondary education according to the criteria listed below.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a senior graduating from Syracuse High School.
2. Plan to attend a trade school, college, or university.
3. Going into, *but not limited to*, an agricultural based field of study.
